ECF Joyful learning in forest ecology - Board game · Outdoor · Environmental Education is an Environmental Education and Community Action Project subsidized by Environment and Conservation Fund and Environmental Campaign Committee.

Hong Kong has always been called a concrete jungle. However, its extremely rich biodiversity is yet to be known by the public. Hence, the programme aims to broaden and deepen students' understanding of the local biodiversity, and to raise their interest and their sense of conservation. The environmental education will be carried out via board game and outdoor education. On the other hand, in order to promote the development of environmental education in Hong Kong, the programme will also focus on the capacity building, knowledge exchange and co-constructing a favourable environment for environmental education.



Objectives

- Deepening the understandings and raising the interests of secondary school students on local forest ecology and biodiversity, by adopting didactics stressing on board game and outdoor education
- Aiding teaching with board game by bringing in line with the curriculum, as well as to promote the effectiveness of the learning and teaching of the subject, and of the environmental education in school
- Providing trainings for tertiary students on the knowledge and action skills of board game and environmental education, ecology and biodiversity, as well as empowering them to apply their learning gains

 Promoting the communication between various environmental education organizations, and thus enhancing the usage and the development of board game environmental education in Hong Kong





















Programme Content

The programme consists of four parts:

1) Tertiary Student Tutors Training, 2) Secondary School Activity Day,

3) Community Centre Activity Day, and 4) Conference on Board Game Environmental Education.

Secondary School Activity Day targets at junior secondary school students (F.1-F.3). By adopting didactics stressing on board game and outdoor education, it aims to deepen the understanding and raising the interest of secondary school students on local forest ecology and biodiversity. Also, by bringing in line with the curriculum, it aids teaching with board game, as well as promotes the effectiveness of the learning and teaching of the subject, and of the environmental education in school.
